1. MULTIPLY DISCIPLE MAKERS

PRIORITIZE YOUR TIME, ENERGY, AND RESOURCES INTO MAKING DISCIPLES THAT BECOME DISCIPLE MAKERS. COMMIT TO MEASURE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF YOUR MINISTRY BY REPRODUCING DISCIPLES WHO MAKE DISCIPLES.

2. SERVE GLOCALLY

LEAD YOUR CHURCH WITH GOD'S MISSIONAL HEART TO SEEK THE LOST AND DISCIPLE THE FOUND LOCALLY AND GLOBALLY. MINISTER INTENTIONALLY TO THE NATIONS THAT ARE AMONG US AND MOBILIZE YOUR CHURCH TO MINISTER ABROAD.

3. DISCIPLE HOLISTICALLY

TRAIN LEADERS THOROUGHLY IN THE AREAS OF HEAD (INFORMATION, BELIEVE), HEART (FORMATION, BE), HANDS (TRANSFORMATION, BEHAVE), AND HABITS (MULTIPLICATION, BECOME).

4. BALANCE DISCIPLESHIP/EVANGELISM

LEAD YOUR MINISTRY TO FULLY EMBRACE GOD'S COMMISSION TO EVANGELIZE AND TO DISCIPLE. ALTHOUGH YOUR PERSONAL GIFTING MAY BE MORE IN ONE AREA THAN THE OTHER, THE CATALYST LEADER SEEKS TO LEAD A MINISTRY THAT EXCELS IN BOTH AREAS.

5. SEEK COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION

SEEK THE LORDSHIP OF JESUS IN YOUR COMMUNITY BY PURSUING THE THREE MISSIONAL OUTCOMES OF DOING GOOD – MAKE A DIFFERENCE; BETTER – MAKE RELATIONSHIPS; AND BEST – MAKE DISCIPLES. CHURCHES INCREASE THEIR EFFECTIVENESS BY PURSUING EACH OF THESE OUTCOMES.
